2. The plaintiff file and serve any affidavits in reply on or before 4pm on 24 March 2020.
3. The plaintiff file and serve written submissions on or before 4pm on 26 March 2020.



4. The defendant file and serve written submissions on or before 4pm on 26 March 2020.
5. The application for injunctive relief be listed on 27 March 2020 at 10:30am before the Honourable Justice McMillan.
6. Costs reserved.
7. Liberty to apply
